**MHT-CET-2017**

The state CET cell is in receipt of various queries through emails, telephone and applications from the candidates. With reference to these queries further clarification is issued though most of the issues are already clarified in earlier notice dated 3/6/2017

- a. As already intimated vide notice No. StateCetCell/MHTCET17/QP/Validation/Notice No. 471, dated 3/6/2017 candidates are aware that The subject experts have opined that four (04) questions in the question papers of the aforesaid examination are non evaluative. The details of "Non-evaluative/ Invalid" MCQ are shown in the **Table No. - 1** at respective Sr. No. in each version.

The answer key for the chemistry subject question number and version number stated above is **D** instead of **A** (Already displayed in the answer keys). It is obvious that the correct answer for the corresponding questions in different versions will also have the same effect. This has been taken care while processing the result.

- b. **Regarding the marks of non evaluative questions:** As per the notice No. StateCetCell/MHTCET17/QP/Validation/Notice No. 471, dated 3/6/2017 5 marks have been allotted to each and every candidate who have appeared for the MHT-CET 2017 for the subjects Physics-Chemistry, Mathematics. And 3 marks have been allotted to each and every candidate who have appeared for the MHT-CET 2017 for the subjects Physics-Chemistry, Biology.  
The care of above matter has been taken while preparing result.
- c. **Name Change or any other correction:** The candidates are advised to contact the facilitation center to edit their information with supporting documents while applying for admission.

- d. **MHT-CET 2017 Rank:** The candidate has to apply for the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) after the registration and confirmation of the application before the scheduled date the merit list (Rank) of registered candidates will be displayed.
- e. **Percentile:** No percentile was calculated for MHT-CET2017.
- f. **Application number / roll number / hall ticket misplaced:** Contact CET Cell / DTE helpline numbers.
- g. **Absent for MHT-CET2017:**  
If the candidate was absent in Physics & Chemistry Paper, he is marked as absent for PCM and PCB both the groups.  
If the candidate was absent in Mathematics Paper, he is marked as absent for PCM group.  
If the candidate was absent in Biology Paper, he is marked as absent for PCB group.  
Candidates are not eligible even though they score marks in other paper.
- h. **Cutoff Marks:** All the candidates those who have secured non zero score and were present for all opted papers in the MHT-CET 2017 are eligible for Engineering and Pharmacy admission.
- i. **Revaluation:** As the question paper, scan copy OMR sheet and answer keys are provided to each and every candidate appeared for MHT-CET2017 and they can verify their score, there is no provision for the revaluation.
