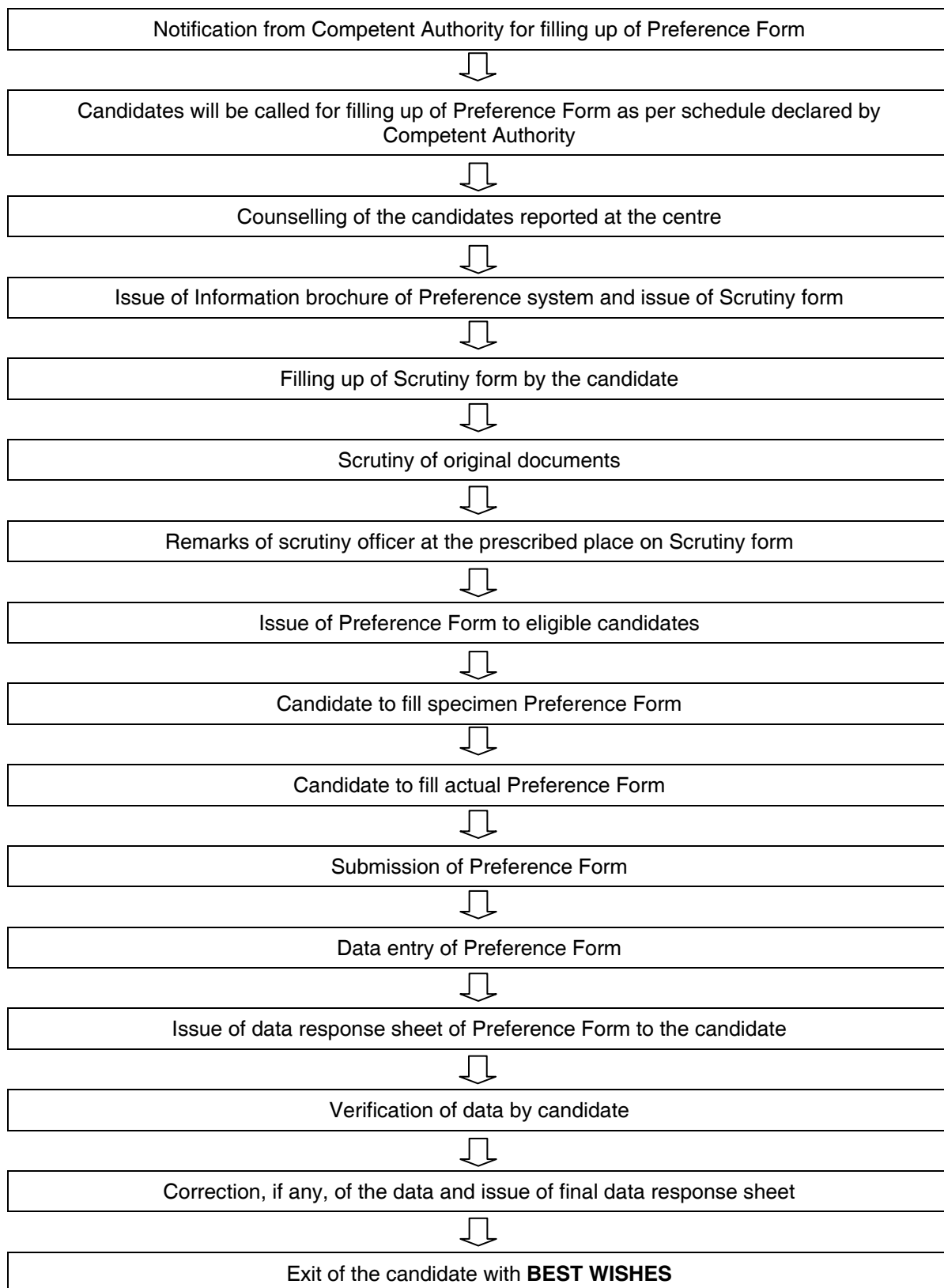

INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

1. Admissions to Postgraduate Courses in Physiotherapy / Occupational therapy / Audio & Speech Language Pathology and Prosthetics & Orthotics Postgraduate [M.P.Th./ M.O.Th./ M.A.S.L.P / MSc.(P&O)] for the academic year 2018-19 will be done by counseling & Preference form filling system. This admission process is for Private unaided, Minority, Government and Corporation Physiotherapy / Occupational therapy / Audio & Speech Language Pathology and Prosthetics & Orthotics college in State of Maharashtra.
2. Candidates from PGP-CET-2018/ PGO-CET-2018/ PGASLP-CET-2018/ MSc (P&O)-CET-2018 State Merit List are called according to their State Merit List (SML) numbers for counseling and Preference form filling at **Auditorium Hall, Govt. Dental College & Hospital, St. Gorges Hospital Campus, Near CST Railway Station, Mumbai- 400 001 on Monday 13/08/2018 & Tuesday 14/08/2018 as below: (Proxy will not be permitted)**

Instructions to Physically Disabled Candidates : All Qualified Persons with Disability PWD (PH) Category Candidates of PGP-CET-2018 are advised to get themselves examined at Medical Board constituted by **Dean, Grant Government Medical College & Sir J.J. Groups of Hospital, Mumbai** in the State of Maharashtra to obtain disability PWD (PH) certificate in advance as per notification no 3 dated 03/08/2018 . Candidates should remain present with 3 copies of recent passport size photograph and 3 copies of full photograph exhibiting physical disability along with relevant document on day of medical examination. Candidates, who have attended this Medical Board, should remain present along with the disability certificate issued by aforesaid Medical Board on respective days of counseling, at Counseling Centre, for Preference Form filling process. Those who have recently obtained disability certificate from either :

- i) **All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Mumbai OR**
- ii) **Vardhaman Mahavir Medical College & Safadarjang Hospital, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi OR**
- iii) **Institute of Post Graduate Medical & Research, Kolkata OR**
- iv) **Madras Medical College, Chennai**, institution, can produce the same disability certificate at the time of Preference Form filling process. It is mandatory to bring disability certificate issued by anyone institution. Candidate without disability certificate will be considered as Non PWD candidate.

3. SEAT DISTRIBUTION CHART:

3.1 The seat distribution of available state quota seats in Government, Corporation colleges, Private unaided and Private Minority Colleges for PGP/PGO/PGASLP/MSc (P&O)-CET 2018 is already made available on DMER website i.e www.mahacet.org. This seats distribution chart contains the college-wise, subject-wise and category-wise distribution of available seats. The seats reserved for person with disability (PWD) candidates have been also shown in the chart.

3.2 The candidates should bring downloaded printout of the same for counseling.

It should be noted that category candidates are eligible and can avail open merit seats by virtue of merit. Category seats, if at all remain unclaimed by a particular category candidate are made available to other categories & to open category candidates as per inter-se category round procedure. **Seat distribution chart is subject to change as per instructions of MUSH, Nashik/ Institute / Transfer of PG Teacher / Hon'ble Courts Order etc.**

3.3 All the Courses are affiliated to The Maharashtra University Health Sciences, Nashik.

3.4 A candidate belonging to backward class from Maharashtra State only is eligible for claiming seat under reserve category.

3.5 There will be no regional reservation. There will be reservation as per Government orders issued from time to time.

3.6 Seats left unfilled in an academic year, shall not be carried forward to the next or subsequent academic year. The cut-off date of admission to all Post Graduate Courses is 30th September, 2018.

4. PERSON WITH DISABILITY (PWD): The candidate should have claimed the Person with Disability (PWD) quota reservation in the original Online application form. For claiming of PWD quota Category, no document are required at time of online registration. Request for PWD category claim after submission application form will not be granted.

As per Medical Council of India, New Delhi amendment notification No: MCI-34(41)/2017-Med/169873 dated 22/01/2018, Five (5%) seats of annual sanctioned intake capacity shall be filled up by candidates with specified benchmark disabilities contained in the schedule to the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, as per **Annexure – ‘C’ of Information Brochure of PGP/PGO/PGASLP/MSc (P&O) 2018.**

The specified disability categories as mentioned in the rights of persons with Disability Act 2016 are as follows.

1. Physical disability
2. Intellectual disability
3. Mental behavior disability
4. Disability caused due to chronic illness
5. Multiple disabilities

1. Candidate is required to submit the proof of his/her disability by way of a certificate issued by certificate issuing authority in the year 2018 at the time of documents verification process.

2. However, such a candidate will be required to undergo medical examination at a special medical board constitute by Competent authority or option disability certificate at any one of the under mentioned Disability Assessment Board, constituted at

i) All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Hazi Ali, Park, K. Khadya Marge, Mahalakshmi, Mumbai OR

ii) Vardhaman Mahavir Medical College & Safadarjang Hospital, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi OR

iii) Institute of Post Graduate Medical & Research, 244, Acharya J.C.Bose Marge, Kolkata OR

iv) Madras Medical College, Park Town, Chennai.

The Medical Board after ascertaining his/her disability must be satisfied that the candidate is physically fit to undergo the course despite his/her disability. (Refer Annexure-C of PGP/PGO/PGASLP/MSc (P&O)-2018 Information Brochure). The person with Disability candidate will have to submit Disability certificate issued by Competent Authority as mentioned above.

5. CONSTITUTIONAL RESERVATION

- 5.1 Constitutional reservation in all the Government, Municipal Corporation and Government aided medical Institutions will be as per PGP/ PGO/ PGASLP/ MSc (P&O)- CET 2018 Information Brochure -Annexure - B
- 5.2 Constitutional reservation in private professional educational institutions will be as per the Maharashtra Government Notification No. MED 2006/1196/CR-204/06/Edu-1 Dated the 24th June, 2006. It directs that the seats to be reserved for the candidates belonging to the reserved category to the said courses shall be twenty five percent (25%) of the sanctioned intake as per PGP/PGO/PGASLP/MSc (P&O)-CET 2018 Information Brochure Annexure - B
- 5.3 Distribution seats in minority colleges will be as per guidelines of prescribed by Government from time to time.

6. FEES: -

- 1) The fees for Government and Municipal Corporation Medical Colleges, Mumbai is as below as per GR. No. AMC-1007/628/CR.148/07/Edu-02 Mantralaya Dated 1st March, 2011 (subject to revision by the Govt. / appropriate authorities):

- Tuition fees Rs.29,400/- per year + (Development Fee 3,000)
- Admission fees Rs.1,500/-
- Gymkhana fees Rs. 500/-
- Hostel fees Rs. 4,000/- per year
- Library fees Rs. 2,000/-

- 2) The private institutions have communicated to the Competent Authority to make admissions at their institution as permitted by Pravesh Niyantran Samiti. The tuition fees and development fees of these private institutions are decided by Shikshan Shulka Samiti. (subject to revision by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti). For the tuition & development fee of private Medical Colleges refer to www.sspnsamiti.gov.in)

7. Selection Process, Document Verification and Preference form System:-

- 7.1 The candidates will give their preferences through a process "Preference form filling process" which has been notified by the Competent Authority on State CET CELL website www.mahacet.org. The procedure regarding document verification, preference form filling process and details of further admission process are made available to the eligible candidates in the preference form brochure which is available on the website. A candidate should be present personally for filling preference form **(Proxy will not be permitted)**. The selection to a course/college will be made considering his/her Final State Merit List Number and preferences

given by the candidate. Candidates as per State Merit List (SML) Number will be called for counselling and asked to fill the preference form at Mumbai on 13/08/2018 & 14/08/2018. Counselling sessions are not meant for instant seats allocation. During these sessions, candidates are assisted in exercising their preferences for various courses and the institutions. Seat allocation shall be made centrally at a later date on the basis of Final State Merit List (SML) and preferences exercised by the candidate.

7.2 **SELECTION PROCESS SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:-** DOCUMENT VERIFICATION AND PREFERENCE FORM SYSTEM

7.2.1 The candidate should present personally for document verification and preference form filling process (**Proxy will not be permitted**). The candidate should submit only one preference form. Submission of more than one preference form shall lead to disqualification.

Candidates should download copy of preference form brochure and read the same carefully

7.2.2 At the time of filling the Preference form the candidate should bring all original documents and a set of self attested copies of the same in support of claim made in application form i.e. Caste Certificate, Caste Validity Certificate, and non-creamy layer certificate. If the matter is still pending with Hon'ble Court, candidate should submit a fresh Court order for PGP-PGO-PGASLP AND MSc (P&O)-CET 2018, failing which claim will not be granted and the candidate will be considered as General Category candidate.

Note :

- 1) Category candidates who do not have Caste Validity Certificate/fresh court order for PG admission regarding Caste Validity, at the time of preference form filling, will be considered as Open merit candidates subject to fulfilling eligibility.
- 2) DT (VJ), NT-1, NT-2, NT-3, OBC category candidates who do not have Non Creamy Layer (valid up to 31/03/2019) at the time of preference form filling will be considered as Open Merit candidates subject to fulfilling eligibility.
- 3) Such category candidates without validity and / or NCL, are considered as Open Merit candidate and will be issued preference form, as open candidate.
- 4) Applicants belonging to SBC : The person belonging to Special Backward Class (SBC) are to be considered as OBC candidates and such candidates will be required to produce Non- Creamy Layer Certificate.

9. For Constitutional reservation category candidates: Ear-Marking - Reserved category candidate entitled to admission on the basis of merit in an open category seat will have the option of taking admission either against his/her respective category seat or on an open category seat. If he/she opts for the reserved category he/she will be deemed to have been admitted as an open category candidate and not as reserved category candidate. One seat in the college where he/she was eligible for admission against open seat shall be earmarked for a candidate belonging to the respective reserved category. Such earmarked seat will be made available immediately to the successive reserved category candidate from the same category merit.

10. Cut-off date for the eligibility: The eligibility of the candidate shall be determined and/or decided for all purposes including for applicability of all these Rules and Regulations by considering the last date of document verification as the cut off date. It

is made abundantly clear that if a candidate is found ineligible as on the last date of document verification process, in terms of these Rules and Regulation, and if such an ineligible candidate acquires the requisite eligibility after the aforesaid cut off date (i.e. the last date of document verification), such subsequent acquisition of eligibility will not make an ineligible candidate eligible for any purpose whatsoever, much less for the purpose of admission.

11. PROCEDURE FOLLOWED AT DOCUMENT VERIFICATION CENTER

11.1 **Orientation:** Candidates will assemble in Govt. Dental College Mumbai as per the programme. They will be given orientation about the process. Counseling for Preference form filling will be done. The candidate must be present in person.

Proxy will not be allowed.

11.2 **Preference Form information brochure:** This Preference form information brochure is made available to candidates on State CET CELL web site i.e. www.mahacet.org. It contains relevant information about the process, State Merit List No. of last admitted candidate for MPTTh/MOTTh/MASLP/MSc (P&O) courses for the academic year 2017-2018, (**Annexure "F"**) subject & college codes, and **specimen copy of Preference form** for practice. Candidates should read the information brochure of Preference system carefully and should bring the downloaded copy of the same for counseling.

11.3 **Scrutiny Form:** Scrutiny form will be issued to the candidates. Candidates should fill in required information. They should arrange documents in order as per list given on scrutiny form i.e. one set of originals and another set of self attested photocopies.

11.4 **Verification of Documents:** Candidates will be called by State Merit List number. They should submit scrutiny form with a set of attested photocopies and show the originals. The documents will be verified by scrutiny officer & eligibility will be endorsed on the scrutiny form. Candidates should not submit original documents.

11.5 **The Subject & College combination code** is a four digit number specific for each college & Subject combination. Candidate can fill minimum one preference and maximum available preferences for available subjects. It is not compulsory to fill all Preferences. The first two digit of the code indicates specific college/institution and last two digit indicates particular subject. eg.

11.6 **College & Subject codes are given to** courses existing in these colleges. For some of these codes the seat(s) may not be available for PGP/PGO/PGASLP/MSc (P&O) CET 2018 Quota during round 1. In the subsequent rounds, some seats may become available. **Therefore, candidates who desire to opt for these seats can exercise the preference in the preference form system for these seats considering eventuality of availability of such seats.**

11.7 **Preference form:** Preprinted Preference form will be issued to eligible candidates after document verification. The candidate should verify the relevant information of his Roll Number, State Merit List Number, Category Merit Number, PGP/PGO/PGASLP/M.Sc (P&O)-CET-2018 Marks etc. Preference form should be handled carefully and should not be folded, stapled or spoilt in any way.

11.8 Candidate will be issued **only ONE Preference Form**. Duplicate / another Preference form will not be issued.

11.9 In case the candidate is not eligible for admission according to rules, the Preference form will not be issued or cancelled if already issued.

11.10 Candidates remaining absent for document verification and process of preference form filling will not be issued preference form after the programme is over.

11.11 Candidate should read all instructions before filling the preference form. Candidate should note carefully the subject & college codes. Candidate must first fill the specimen copy of preference form given in the brochure with pencil for practice. Once the candidate is satisfied with his / her choices filled on specimen copy of preference form, then he should start filling the actual preference form using **black ball point pen**.

- 11.12 Candidate should write his most preferred subject and college code as preference no. 1 followed by his next choice as preference no. 2 and so on. While filling the subject and college codes, number should be written in boxes, one digit in each box (4 digit number - 4 boxes) for PGP/PGO/PGASLP/MSc (P&O)-CET candidates. **As the form will be scanned by Computer, candidate should write the codes with black ball point pen and with neat, legible, clear handwriting.**
- 11.13 Candidate must be very careful while filling the preference form. Candidate can fill minimum one preference or any desired number of preferences or maximum available preferences for PGP/PGO/PGASLP/MSc (P&O)-CET 2018. The same code should not be filled more than once. In case the candidate fills the same code more than once, higher preference will be considered and subsequent repeated preference(s) will be ignored. If the candidate fills wrong code number that preference will not be considered.
- 11.14 If a candidate does not give preference for a particular code (Government / Corporation / Private); then it means that he / she is not interested / desiring to take that PG seat. Candidate should note that there will be no change / addition / deletion in his / her list of preferences at later date / stage.
- 11.15 After the first Preference Form round, Competent Authority may conduct subsequent preference round(s), based on the same preference form. For aforesaid round those candidates who have not joined / resigned after allotment of seat(s) will not be considered eligible.
- 11.16 The candidate should submit his duly filled Preference form at the specified counter. Candidate shall inform regarding any correction in the name if required at the counter.
- 11.17 **Data Response Sheet & Verification:-** Data response sheet of Preference Form in duplicate will be generated and will be given to the candidate for verification. Candidate should check that the data i.e. SML No. Name, Category etc. and his Preferences and subject college combination codes have been correctly printed. After verification the candidate will report any discrepancy in the data and it will be duly corrected according to his/her preference form. If the candidate does not report any discrepancy, it will be presumed that the data entered against his/her name is correct and subsequently corrections/ alterations will not be made at later date.
- The candidate should sign the data response sheet copies. Candidate will be given a copy of data response sheet.

11.18 Candidate should note that the **Preferences** of subject and college combination codes, once entered in the record/data, after verification by the candidate, shall be **final and irrevocable**. Thereafter there can not be any change, addition or deletion of Preferences entered by the candidate. This final data shall be used in entire selection process for the admission to MPTh/MOTh/MASLP/MSc (P&O) Postgraduate courses.

12. SEAT ALLOTMENT PROCESS :

12.1 Based on preferences given, the seats will be allotted on merit and the allotment will be displayed on website of State CET CELL i.e. 'www.mahacet.org' All the candidates to whom a seat has been allotted in the 1st round on the basis of Merit-cum-Preference will have to compulsorily join the college and course so allotted, with in prescribed period by completing the requisite formalities. i.e submission of original documents as per the list given in Clause No.8 of this brochure and payment of requisite fees.

12.2 If a candidate gets selected for a particular MPTh/MOTh/MASLP/MSc (P&O) postgraduate course, then the candidate is required to join that course as per the procedure. In case he / she does not join the course, he / she will not be eligible for subsequent admission process of PGP/PGO/PGASLP/MSc (P&O)-CET 2018.

12.3 **It is made clear that even if a candidate to whom a seat has been allotted in the 1st round wants a betterment of his/her choice, such a candidate must initially accept the allotment and join the college by completing the necessary formalities as set out by these Rules, failing which such a candidate will be thrown out of the entire admission process of the current academic year 2018-2019.**

If any candidate to whom a seat has been allotted in the 1st round does not join the college and course seat so allotted, it will be presumed that such a candidate is not interested in the admission process and for all further round(s) of admission, such candidate shall not be considered for allotment of any seat whatsoever.

The seat so allotted to such a candidate who does not join, will be presumed to be a vacant seat as on and from the next date after the date set out as the last date for joining the college in terms of such allotment. Such a vacant seat will be allotted in the next round of admission process within prescribed period.

- 12.4 All the candidates who have filled the preference form and to whom a seat could not be allotted in the round will be held eligible for allotment of a seat in the subsequent Round(s).
- 12.5 For filling of vacant seats after first round, same preferences will be considered for subsequent computerized rounds and no separate preference form will be required to be filled by the candidate (except for final round by personal appearance). For aforesaid computerized round those candidates who have not joined / Resigned after allotment of seat(s) will not be considered eligible.

13. STATUS RETENTION:

- 13.1 All the candidates who have joined in the round (s) on allotted seat, will be given a stipulated period to fill the status retention form. In case if a candidate to whom a seat has been allotted in the preference form round(s) and who has joined the college accordingly, is satisfied with the allotment, such a candidate must submit a Status-Retention Form (Annexure-B) in the given format on or before prescribed date with the Dean of the College where such a seat has been allotted to such a candidate. The Dean of every Medical College to which admissions are so made in terms of these rules, may appoint an appropriate Officer to receive such Status Retention Forms. Upon receipt of such Status Retention Forms, an acknowledgement in writing shall be issued immediately to the concerned candidates by the officer appointed by the Head of Institution. The college authority should immediately update the student status retentions online in the **College Feedback Module** on the website www.mahacet.org for status retention process. It is mandatory for every such candidate submitting a Status Retention Form to insist for issuance of acknowledgement thereof and to preserve such acknowledgement till the present admission process is finally concluded. In absence of such an acknowledgement, the claim of submission of Status Retention Form within the prescribed time shall not be entertained. Candidate who has submitted status retention forms will not be eligible for personnel counseling round(s).
- 13.2 **It is hereby made clear that the period provided for submission of Status Retention Form is crucial and vital. This period shall not be extended for any reason whatsoever. Submission of the Status Retention Form is an irrevocable and irreversible act for the candidate submitting such Status Retention Form. It is made clear that under no circumstances whatsoever, a candidate will be allowed to submit a Status Retention Form after the**

aforsaid last date. Under any circumstances whatsoever, a candidate who has submitted a Status Retention Form shall not be allowed to withdraw the same either before or any time after the aforsaid last date. All the candidates therefore, are hereby called upon to carefully consider their case before submission of such a Status Retention Form. Names of all the candidates who have submitted the Status Retention Form as above within the prescribed time and the seats occupied by them will be removed out of consideration for the remaining admission process.

All such candidates to whom seat has been allotted in the earlier round and who have accordingly joined the college if do not submit the 'status retention form' as set out herein and if gets a betterment in the subsequent round as per his higher choice, then it is mandatory to join the allotted college. If a candidate doesn't get a betterment on his higher choies in subsequent rounds, then he/she will remain on his previous allotted seat.

13.3 After the first round, Competent Authority may conduct subsequent round(s), based on the same preference forms, and no separate preference shall be required to be filled by the candidate. For these subsequent computerized round(s) those candidates who are (a) selected but not joined, (b) joined and resigned and (c) Those who have filled status retention will not be considered eligible for further admission process.

14. Mop-Up Round (s) : After conducting two rounds of seat allotments for Government/ Corporation and State quota of Central Government/Government Aided / Unaided Private/Minority Medical colleges, if seats remain vacant due to non allotment, non reporting for admission and resigning after joining or any other reason, such seats will be filled in **Mop-Up round(s)**. The details of the Mop Up round(s) will be declared by way of notice on the web site in due course.

Following candidates are Not Eligible for Mop-Up Rounds

- a) Candidate to whom a seat has been allotted in computerized CAP rounds and not joined
- b) Candidate who has filled status retention form
- c) Those candidates who are joined and resigned after allotment of seats.

15. INSTITUTION LEVEL ROUND FOR VACANT SEATS AFTER CAP Mop-Up ROUND(S):

If the seat(s) remain vacant in Private Unaided /Private Minority Colleges after CAP Mop-Up Round(s), the said seats shall be filled in by the Institution through Institution Level Round with the prior approval of the Competent Authority. The Dean or Principal of the institutions shall carry out the admission for these vacant seats on the basis of inter-se merit from the list of PGP/PGO/PGASLP/MSc (P&O) CET 2018 eligible candidates as per the directions issued by the Competent Authority during academic year 2018-19.

16. THE CONDITIONS TO BE SATISFIED BY CANDIDATE AFTER SELECTION:

16.1 A candidate will have to pay the prescribed fees as decided by Govt./ BMC/ All India Institutes / Private Institutes from time to time (i.e. tuition + deposit + others). He/she should deposit all relevant original certificates / documents in the concerned institution.

16.2 All selected candidates will have to submit DD/Pay order of 650/- drawn on any Nationalized/Scheduled Commercial Bank in favour of "NATIONAL INSURANCE COMPANY LIMITED, KOLHAPUR" Payable at Kolhapur for Amartya Shikshan Yojana as per GR.MED/100/880/CR-129/Edu-1, dated 13/10/2003 submitted to the concerned Institution.

17. CANCELLATION AND REFUND:

17.1 Candidate who has confirmed his/her admission may cancel it by submitting an application to the concerned Dean.

17.2 Candidate cancelling his/her admission on or before **10/09/2018** will be held eligible for subsequent PG entrance examination in 2019.

17.3 Candidate canceling his/her admission after 10/09/2018 will not be eligible for subsequent PGP-CET / PGO-CET / PGASLP-CET/ M.Sc. (P&O)-CET 2019 Examination.

17.4 Refund of fees by the college after change of college / course or cancellation of admission.

On or before 10/09/2018: Rs.1500/- to be deducted as administration charges and remaining tuition fee and deposit(s) to be refunded.

After 10/09/2018:No refund of fees & deposit(s).

17.5 If a candidate expires or becomes invalid within 3 months from the date of admission, full refund shall be made by the Dean after deducting Rupees One

Thousand as administrative charges. The refund will only be made by the Dean after 3 months from the date of application for refund. No correspondence shall be entertained by Competent Authority/Dean in this matter during this period.

18. DISCIPLINE:

- 18.1 If any candidate / authorized representative or person accompanying is found obstructing the counseling and / or admission process, or trying to influence in unlawful manner/ creating nuisance, the candidate shall be liable for disqualification from the process of selection. The decision taken by the Competent Authority in this respect shall be final and binding.
- 18.2 The registration once granted is valid only if the teacher and the Dean are satisfied about regularity, good conduct as well as diligent pursuance of studies by the student.
- 18.3 Candidate selected and admitted is bound by disciplinary rules of University / Institution / State Government and local authority.
- 18.4 A candidate selected for M.P.Th./ M.O.Th./ M.A.S.L.P. / M Sc. (P & O) course will not be allowed to change subject / college / institute / place on mutual basis.
- 18.5 In case of dispute in the matter of allotment of seat / course / institution or any other matter pertaining to the provisional selection or cancellation of admission, the decision of the **Competent Authority shall be final and binding.**

19. UNDERTAKING AND PENALTY:

- 19.1 Candidate selected for postgraduate course will be required to submit an undertaking for completion of course failing which he/she will be required to pay Rs.1,00,000/- for the default (i.e. non completion of course). However, this is not applicable to the candidates of PGP-CET-2018 / PGO-CET-2018 / PGASLP-CET-2018 / M Sc. (P&O)-CET 2018 resigning the course before prescribed date.
 - 19.2 It is made hereby clear that in case such a candidate does not join the concerned College and/or fails to comply with the necessary formalities of the admission within the prescribed time, such a candidate shall not be eligible for appearing at next one succeeding CET conducted for grant of admissions to post-graduate courses in the State of Maharashtra i.e. CET 2019-20 and will have to pay Rs 1,00,000/- as penalty for lapse of post graduation medical seat.
- 20.** Any issue not dealt here-in above will be dealt with, when arising, fully and finally by the Competent Authority.

4. As per the selection list the candidate should report to respective course and college on or before **23rd August, 2018** along with original documents and prescribed fees. Candidate will not be given separate selection letter.
