Eligibility for admission process :

- 1) All desirous candidates who have not registered with State CET Cell and appeared for NEET-UG-2018 as well as who are eligible as per NEET-UG-2018 brochure for the State of Maharashtra.
 - 2) All desirous candidates who are previously registered but not joined to any of Health Science Courses through NEET-UG-2018. **Such candidates can fill choices/preferences of newly permitted and previously permitted colleges and their previous choices/preferences will be null & void.** (Except for six colleges allowed for institutional level round as per notice of DMER dated 30/10/2018)
 - 3) All desirous candidates who are joined to any Health Science Course has to cancel his/her admission before online registration to be eligible for 2nd CAP round onwards.
 - 4) The candidate who have done online registration should pay Rs.1060/- through challan at any branch of the SBI up to 12/11/2018.
 - 5) The online preference/choices can be filled for minimum one college and maximum for all Colleges. (excluding six private B.Sc.Nursing Colleges as per Notice of DMER dated 30/10/2018)
 - 6) The candidate will have to upload all the requisite documents as mentioned in the information brochure of NEET-UG-2018. After verifying the eligibility from the online submitted documents, the category claim will be granted.
 - 7) **The candidates admitted after 31/10/2018 in this admission process will not be granted Academic term as per MUHS, Nasik.**
 - 8) The selected candidates in this new round will have to submit Original documents & pay requisite fees by Cheque/DD.
- **Procedure for Institutional Round for all newly permitted and previously permitted B.Sc.Nursing Colleges.**
 - 1) All the previously registered and newly registered candidate who are having non admitted status on 22/11/2018 will be eligible.
 - 2) List of eligible candidates will be published on the website on 24/11/2018.
 - 3) Institutional Round is for Government / Private Unaided / Minority colleges for B.Sc.Nursing course for seats remaining vacant after 22nd November 2018 Institutional level round.
 - 4) For institutional round eligible and interested candidates should approach to the Dean/Principal of the respective colleges within prescribed time and submit application in person. Such type of applications should not be submitted in the State CET CELL/DMER in person or email. Such type

of applications submitted in State CET CELL/DMER will not be considered valid for any institutional level admission process.

- 5) In the institutional level round, the choice / preference given previously by the candidate become null and void. The candidates will be granted admission on the basis of merit list of respective college for which he/she has applied for institutional round.
- 6) At the time of admission, Candidate should submit all original documents and requisite fees in prescribed time, no extra time will be given.
- 7) The candidates will not be granted admission on the basis of Bonafide / Holding certificate. It is the sole responsibility of candidate to submit all the requisite documents at the time of admission.
